



Metro Esports - Minecraft Server Parental Consent Form

All virtual interaction will be pre planned and communicated with you prior to the online session going live. All sessions will be delivered by Metro Esports staff who hold relevant clearances and have been through our safer recruitment process.

About Minecraft:

Minecraft is a sandbox-adventure video game. The style is called "sandbox" because it provides a creative landscape with no fixed goal and endless possibilities. Its blocky design is rather kid-like, too: Characters' heads are square, colors appear in chunks, and even trees look like they were grown in a Lego lab. Like any playground, Minecraft doesn't come with instructions, and it's relatively simple to pick up and play. You learn the game through exploration, experimentation, watching YouTube videos, and reading other fan-created content (there's a lot of it online). And the more you play, the more you learn what to do and how to use the available resources, such as redstone and different kinds of ore, to make ever-more-complex tools and structures.

Player Registration:

Virtual interaction and online engagement for Metro Esports's Minecraft server for anyone under 18 years old will only take place **where explicit parental / guardian consent is obtained via this form.**

No personal details, such as real names or email accounts, will be shared with other users and all personal data will be treated in accordance with Data Protection and GDPR Policies. Users will be required to first register with Metro Esports via a secure form on <https://cbsd.metroesports.gg> .
